SI paragraphs 1.2., 5.1., 8.4., 10, 13.1., 14, 21 are deleted and changed as follows:

1.2. Current edition (2018 03 01) of Platu Class Rule 2018

5.1. Thursday, 07.26 9:00-20:00 Arrival and registration

Friday, 07.27 10:00 Opening ceremony and competitors briefing
11:55 Warning signal for the first practice race

Not earlier than 12:30 Windward/Leeward races

17:00 Warning signal for In-port race in the port of Klaipėda

Saturday, 07.28 9:00 Competitors briefing

10:55 Warning signal for the first race of the day

Sunday, 07.29 9:00 Competitors briefing

10:55 Warning signal for the first race of the day

16:30 Closing ceremony, prizegiving

8.4. Course will not be changed after the preparatory signal. This changes RRS 33

10. The start

10.1. Races will be started by using rule RRS 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the starting signal

10.2. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat at starboard end and the course side of the mark S at the port end of the starting line.

10.3. A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes rule RRS A4.

13.1. Target time for Windward/Leeward race is 30 minutes. Violation of this rule cannot be grounds for request for redress.

14. Protests and Requests for Redress

14.1. In addition to complying with RRS 61.1, a protesting boat shall inform the Race Committee by voice of her intention to protest and the identity of the protested boat(s) as soon as possible after finishing or retiring.

14.2. Protest forms are available at the race office. Protest shall be delivered there within the time limits which shall be for each class: 120 minutes after last boat has finished the last race of the day. The same time limit applies to protests by the race committee and protest committee about incident they observe in the racing area and for the requests for redress. This change RRS 61.3 and 62.2.

14.3. When unofficial results are posted after the protest time limit expires, requests for redress upon unofficial results may be lodged within 30 minutes after posting. This change RRS 62.2

14.4. Notice to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named of witnesses will be posted within 30 minutes of the protest time limit.

14.5. On the last day of the regatta a requests for reopening a hearing shall be Delivered

14.5.1. within the protest time limit if the party requesting reopening was informed of the decision on the previous day.

14.5.2. no later then 30 minutes after the party requesting reopening was

informed of the decision on that day. This changes RRS 66

21. Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta starting from July 26th 20:00 except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
